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COVID-19 Update #8: "Part-time" Attendance - different classes on different days

Thank you so much whānau for your patience and understanding as we have prepared for the next phase of returning to School. The Minister of Education has called it "Part-Time Attendance".

IMPORTANT:

- Please refer to our *COVID-19 Update #7 letter 11 November* posted on our School Website and Facebook page, last week.

"Part-time Attendance" means....

- We must manage **smaller numbers of students and staff attending each day**, so that everyone can be as safe as possible
- The **Part-time Attendance Register** is now finished. Thank you for getting back to Miss Sharon and Mrs Sharma with your intentions, number planning has been important!
- **Different classes on different days** (capped number of students in your child's "usual" class)
- We have a **Part-time Attendance Timetable** which has been shared with your child's teacher, showing what days are "at School" and what days are "at home" distance learning
- If your tamariki are on our Part-time Attendance Register, they will be with their "**usual teacher**" at School
- **Some students won't be attending Part-time School** and we respect that whānau prefer their tamariki to continue with distance learning from home
- We'll continue to review our safety plan each day, make adjustments as needed and update you

Your child's teacher will be in contact with you tomorrow via the usual ways. We'll put out a reminder tomorrow too.

Other information ...

- We're **preparing refreshed learning packs** and hopefully our MoE packs will arrive this week too. We can then organise getting those out to tamariki 😊
