New COVID19 Protection Framework (CPF)

You'll have heard the Government's announcement that everyone in Aotearoa will move to the *new COVID19 Protection Framework (CPF) "Traffic Light" system* on Friday, 3 December. Auckland will be moving to CPF **Red**.

The rest of this year

The Ministry of Education (MoE) has confirmed that Schools retain their existing COVID19 settings until the end of the 2021 calendar year. So for us, we'll be continuing with our current way of operating with our parttime attendance/blended learning model for the remainder of the term (last day of Term is Friday 17 December).

Please remember to contact your child's teacher or call the Office if your circumstances change.

Next year

We can confirm that everyone will be back on site for learning from the start of the School year, **Thursday 3 February 2022 (first day of Term One)**, regardless of what setting we'll be in under the new *CPF "Traffic Light" system* (**Red/Orange/Green**). This is fabulous news and means we can continue with our plans for an awesome 2022. Yay!

Health measures in place at School

This year and next, health, safety and hauora will continue to be a priority for us. The same Public Health measures you are very familiar with, will remain in place:

- good hygiene and cleaning
- contact tracing systems in place
- vaccination requirements for workers (paid and unpaid)
- if you are sick, you must stay home and get tested
- good ventilation.

And if we are at **Red** at any stage next year:

- face coverings will be required at School when indoors for students and staff Years 4 to 8
- physical activities and singing held outside only
- keeping 1 m distance between different groups
- children with complex medical needs can seek advice from their health professional
- we'll ask that only essential visitors come onsite.



With all these safety measures in place, Public Health has confirmed the risk of infection remains low when at School, with households continuing to be where COVID19 is spreading the most (reference: Dr Caroline McElnay, Director of Public Health).

What if we have a confirmed COVID19 case at School?

If we have someone confirmed with COVID19 in our School, we have a plan to manage this and will follow the guidance of our MoE Director, and contact you as soon as possible. Contact tracing systems and case management will continue.
